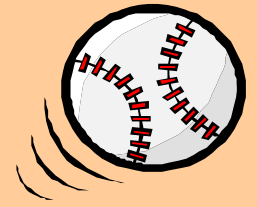


Baseball Math

2 to 4 players

Directions:

Take turns drawing a baseball card and answering the math problem on the back. If the answer is correct, spin the spinner and follow the directions:

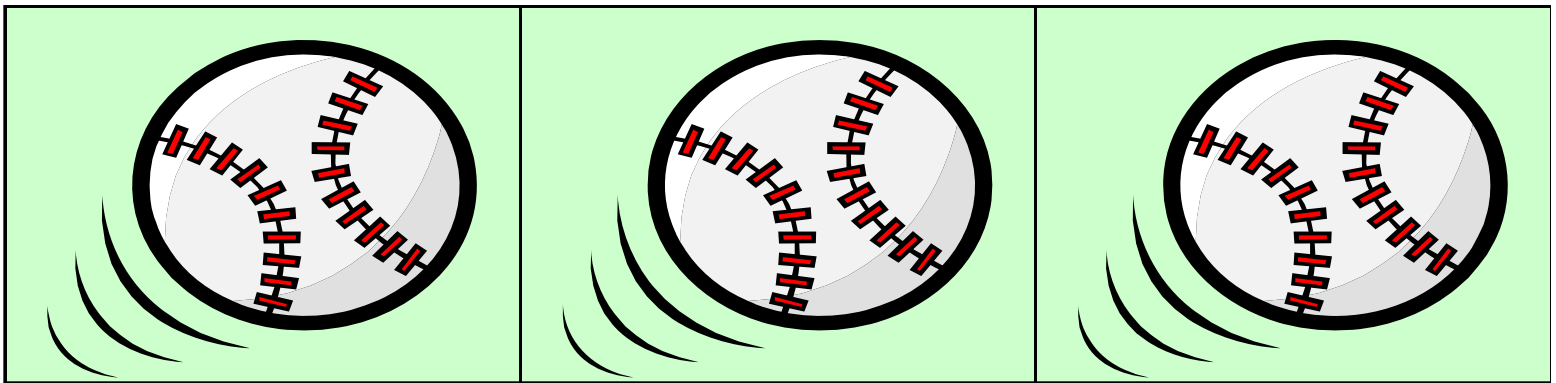
You're out! -- Go home with no score

Home run! -- Go home and score

Single -- Move one base

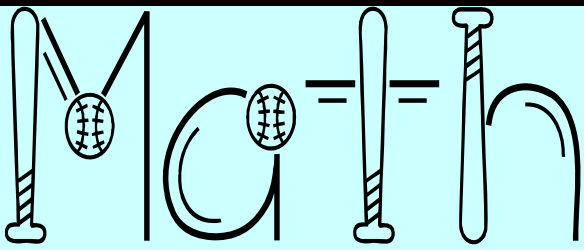
Double -- Move two bases or home if player is on 3rd.

Keep you moving marker on the base until your next turn. If you answer the math problem incorrectly you strike out, and if you are on a base you must go home with no score. Keep a scoresheet of how many home runs each player makes. The player with the most home runs after each player has had nine turns is the winner.

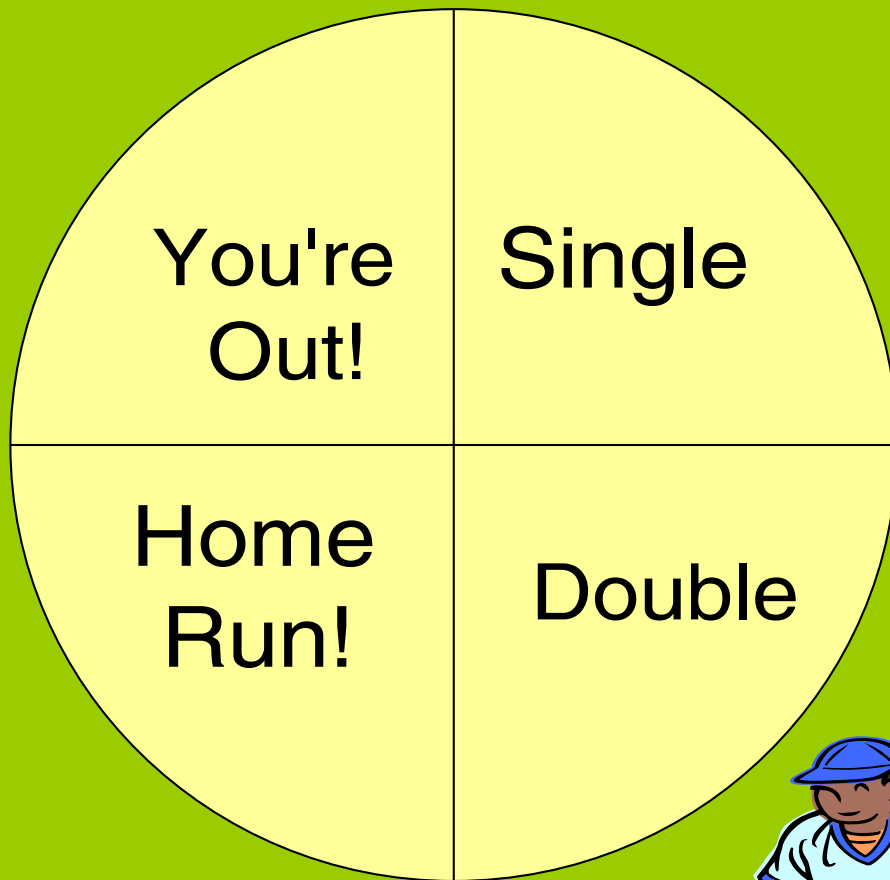


Game Assembly Directions:

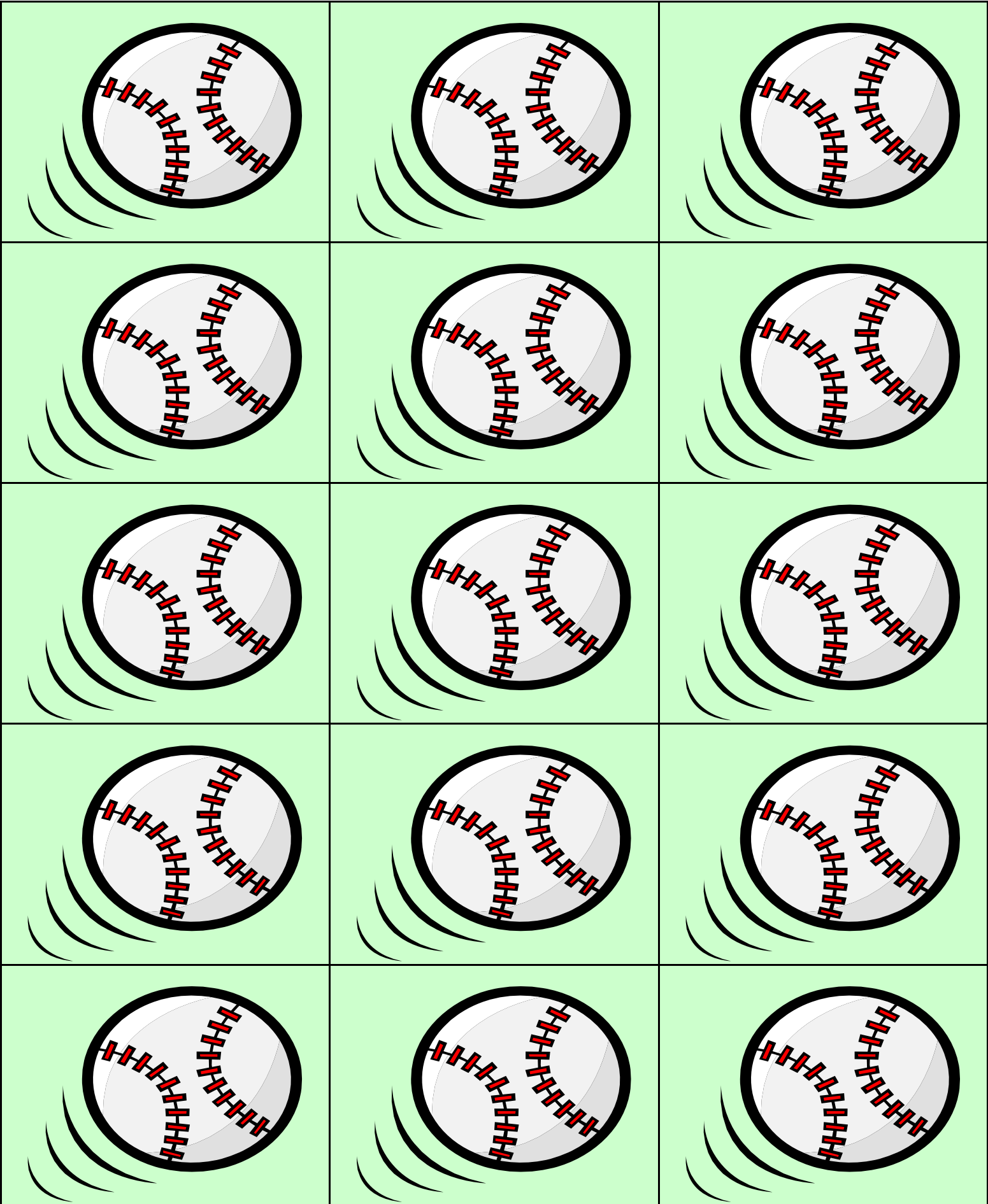
Use old board game moving markers, erasers, small toys, etc. Trim the inside edges of the left and right game board and tape together. Attach a paper clip to the center of the spinner with a paper fastener. Cut out the baseball cards and write math problems on the back. Number the cards and make an answer sheet so players can check each other's answers. Tape the directions to the front of a gallon size baggy and keep the game board, cards, answer sheet and moving markers inside.



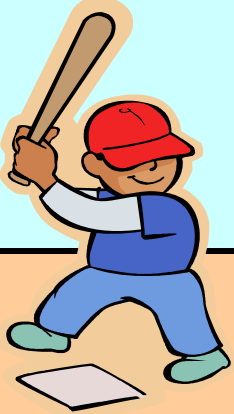

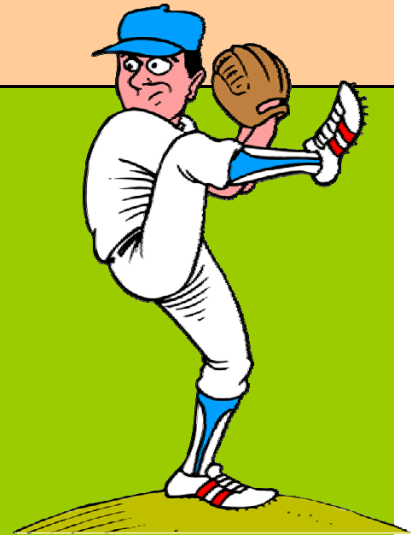
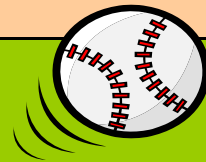
